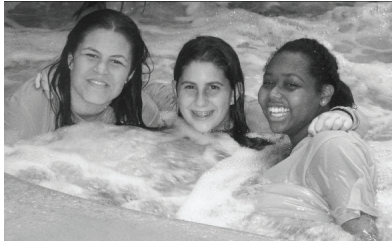


About Our Camp

respect for each other and the world around them. Each camper will enjoy a wide variety of activities that continues the learning process throughout the summer, all supervised by our quality, caring and enthusiastic staff.

About Our Staff

The Boys & Girls Club of Woburn takes pride in our dedicated, energetic and well trained staff. All staff members take part in a selective interview process that includes CORI and SORI background checks to ensure the safety of all our campers. Our caring and responsible staff members are role models that work to instill a sense of: competence, usefulness, belonging and influence in every camper. All staff members are trained in First Aid and CPR, as well as their respective areas of instruction including life guarding and water safety.



Parent engagement is important to us! Feedback, suggestions, and concerns are welcome at all times. You have the right to review background checks, grievance procedures, health care and discipline policies. Your child's safety, well-being and positive camp experience are our top priorities.

Something New &

The day begins at 9:00 am with an all camp meeting and ends with group time at 5:30 pm. *Extended care is available from 7:30-9:00 am.

Discovery Camp (for ages 5&6)

A junior version of our camp experience, campers participate in age appropriate activities in a nurturing environment with a 1:5 counselor ratio.

Explorer Camp (for ages 7-9)

Campers participate in a variety of fun, engaging and educational activities that revolve around each weekly theme. Groups are separated by age, and kept at a 1:10 ratio to ensure a positive camp experience.

Venture Camp (for ages 10&11)

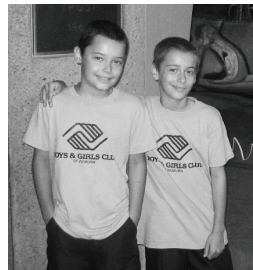

Quest Camp (for ages 12-14)

Campers participate in a variety of fun, engaging and educational activities that revolve around each weekly theme. Groups are separated by age, and kept at a 1:10 ratio to ensure a positive camp experience.

CIT Camp (for ages 12-14)

Mature campers are able to receive on-the-job training working with children. This camp allows CITs (counselors in training) to participate in traditional camp experiences, while developing their teaching techniques, leadership and decision making skills.
